- . Less than 56% of households have access to safe water and only 25% benefit from adequate sanitation.

- . Haiti is about the size of the state of Maryland.
- . Approx. 9.7 Million people live on the island.
- . There are approx. 900 people per sq. mile.
- . In comparison the U.S. has about 70 people per sq. mile

- . Haiti has 7 doctors per 100,000 people.
- . Approx. 7% of babies die at birth.
- . 5% die before they reach 5 years old.
- . The average life span is 53 years.

- . Only 45% of Haitians can read or write.
- . 50% of urban Haitians are unemployed.
- . Most Haitians live on \$2. or less a day.
- . The top 4% of Haitians have 66% of the wealth
